DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORT

Dexter Shelby, Director of Public Works updated the board on how much trash and hazardous waste was collected at the recent city wide cleanup days event. Dexter reported that the City collected 24 30 cubic yard containers of trash. Dexter then updated the board on the number of new water accounts, total number of work orders, and the total number of work orders completed for the months of September 2016 and October 2016. Finally, a report was given on the progress of the various drainage projects the department was working on throughout the City.

MAYOR'S DISCUSSION AND REPORTS

APPROVAL OF PROPERTY AND LIABILITY INSURANCE AND WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017

Ben Todd, with Todd & Associates, presented a proposal from Trident Insurance Company for fire, auto liability and worker's compensation insurance for the fiscal year 2016 – 2017.

MOTION made by Alderwoman Cossitt and SECONDED by Alderman Barnett the board approved the proposal of \$492,103 from Trident Insurance Company as the lowest and best bid, furthermore the board approved the \$1,500 agent fee in the Worker's Compensation Insurance premium. Upon presentation by Chelsea Brannon, City Attorney, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Barnett and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Ellis the board authorized a waiver and removal of fine assessed to subsequent owner in tax year 2015 for a cleaning occurring in 2014, unrecorded at time of purchase by current owner, for Parcel 2862-111-593, also identified as 900 Dogwood Street, Clinton, Mississippi. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

AUTHORIZE THE REJECTION OF ALL BIDS RECEIVED ON AUGUST 11, 2016 IN RESPONSE TO THE CITY'S ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE STATION #4

Upon presentation by Jeff Blackledge, Fire Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderwoman Cossitt and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Cashion the board authorized the rejection of all bids received on August 11, 2016 in response to the City's advertisement for bids for construction of Fire Station #4. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

ACCEPT A PROPOSAL BY CANON SOLUTIONS AMERICA FOR A DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT & CAPTURE SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF CLINTON, AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, WITH CANON SOLUTIONS AMERICA FOR A TERM OF 36 MONTHS

Upon presentation by Jimmy Baldree, Deputy City Clerk, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Brabham and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Cossitt the board accepted the proposal by Canon Solutions America for a Document Management & Capture System for the City of Clinton, and furthermore authorized the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City of Clinton, with Canon Solutions America for a term of 36 months. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>
