UNKEMPT PROPERTY LOCATED AT 815 NORTHSIDE DRIVE

Upon presentation by Angie Gelston, Compliance Officer, MOTION made by Alderman Greer and SECONDED by Alderwoman Cossitt the board approved a resolution determining the necessity for cleaning the property located at 815 Northside Drive, under the authority granted to municipalities by Section 21-19-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and other applicable statutes and ordinances. Furthermore, the board approved giving the property owner two weeks to clean the property before the City would begin to enforce the resolution. A public hearing was held and neither the owner nor anyone representing the owner of the property was present. No one from the public made any comments. The resolution is on file with the City Clerk. Alderman Cronin left the meeting at 7:04 pm prior to the discussion of this item and returned to the meeting at 7:13 pm. Alderman Cronin did not participate in the discussion of the item nor did he vote on this item. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

Upon his return to the meeting, Alderman Cronin stated that he fully supported the efforts of the Code Enforcement Department to maintain the appearance of the City and he would fully cooperate in these efforts.

APPROVE A PROCLAMATION TO DECLARE SEPTEMBER 24, 2013 "NENAMOOSHA DAY" IN CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI

Upon presentation by Phil Fisher, Mayor, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Greer and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Barnett the board approved a Proclamation to declare September 24, 2013 "Nenamoosha Day" in Clinton, Mississippi. <u>MOTION CARRIED</u> UNANIMOUSLY

ACCEPT A PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY C-SPIRE BUSINESS SOLUTIONS FOR A (36) THIRTY SIX MONTH TERM CITYWIDE TELEPHONE SYSTEM

Upon presentation by Jimmy Baldree, Deputy City Clerk, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Barnett and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Ellis the board accepted a proposal from C-Spire Business Solutions for a (36) thirty six month term Citywide Telephone System as being the lowest and best proposal for \$5,507.00 per month. During the discussion of this item, it was pointed out that this action would improve communication service within the City and also result in significant savings. Mayor Fisher stated that the City was involved in an ongoing process to reduce the number of lines and simultaneously promote efficiency. <u>MOTION</u> CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

APPROVE A CITYWIDE PURCHASING POLICY

Upon presentation by Russell Wall, City Clerk, MOTION made by Alderman Cronin and SECONDED by Alderwoman Cossitt the board approved the revised Citywide Purchasing Policy. City Clerk wall explained the basics of state purchasing law and the incorporation of it into the guidelines. The Mayor reminded Department Heads that the City would use the State contract price for purchases unless a lower price was available. The Department Heads were also given authority to make purchases of up to \$1000.00 under the new policy. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

APPROVE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A GENERAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI AND M & G ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

Upon presentation by Mike Parker, Director of Public Works, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Ellis and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Cossitt the board approved authorizing the Mayor to execute a General Services Agreement between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and M & G Enterprises, Inc. for professional engineering services. <u>MOTION CARRIED</u> UNANIMOUSLY

ANNOUNCEMENTS
