DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORT

Anna Boyd Hawks, Assistant Director of Main Street discussed with the board her plans for marketing the train station. She announced that since the opening of the train station there has been 15 meetings with 340 participants and overall a total of 640 people has visited the train station since its opening. Anna announced that the staff is focusing on the year 1875 with various exhibits for visitors to view. Also, there has been a program for reading to kids, the formation of a rail club, and a summer camp for kids is planned for July 2018. 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ACKNOWLEDGE THE REQUEST BY VERIZON TO PLACE THREE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED ANTENNAS ON THE CITY'S WATER TANK LOCATED ON HIGHWAY 80 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT EXECUTED JUNE 26, 2015 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, INCLUDING A LETTER OF CONSENT
