Upon presentation by William Purdie, City Attorney, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Perritt and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Cashion the board approved a Water Tower and Cellular Communications Commercial Lease Agreement between the Clinton Public School District and the City of Clinton, Mississippi. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>
