Upon presentation by Russell Wall, City Clerk, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cashion and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Ellis the board authorized the Mayor to execute an Agreement between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and Hinds County, Mississippi for the use of Election Equipment for the Municipal Elections to be held on April 6th, April 27th (if necessary), and June 8th, 2021. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

<u>APPROVAL FOR CPD TO ACCEPT THE 2020 – 2021 MCOPS GRANT AWARD</u> <u>FROM THE CLINTON PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF</u> <u>EDUCATION TOTALING \$30,000</u>
