Upon presentation by Butler, Snow, O'Mara, Stevens & Cannada, PLLC, MOTION made by Alderman Hisaw and SECONDED by Alderman Morgan the board approved a resolution authorizing and directing the issuance of General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2013, of the City of Clinton, Mississippi, in the principal amount of not to exceed nine million two hundred thousand dollars (\$9,200,000) to raise money for the purpose of providing funds for the (I) (a) advance refunding of certain outstanding maturities of the City's General Obligation Bonds, Series 2006, dated July 1, 2006, issued in the original principal amount of \$3,870,000; (b) the refinance, prepayment and advance refunding of the certain outstanding principal installments of the City's Promissory Note (Clinton, Mississippi recreation facilities and municipal buildings project), dated November 1, 2004, issued in the original principal amount of \$7,750,000, securing a loan agreement, dated as of November 1, 2004, by and between the City and the Mississippi Development Bank, evidencing a loan between the City and the Mississippi Development Bank, and the subsequent advance refunding and redemption of certain outstanding maturities of the \$7,750,000 Mississippi Development Bank Special Obligation Bonds, Series 2004 (Clinton, Mississippi recreation facilities and municipal buildings project), dated as of November 1, 2004, issued pursuant to an indenture of trust, dated as of November 1, 2004, by and between the Mississippi Development Bank and Trustmark National Bank, Jackson, Mississippi; and (c) current refunding of all outstanding maturities of the City's General Obligation Water and Sewer System Bonds, Series 1998, dated March 1, 1998, issued in the original principal amount of \$1,600,000, and (ii) payment of cost of issuance in connection therewith.
