## About Us

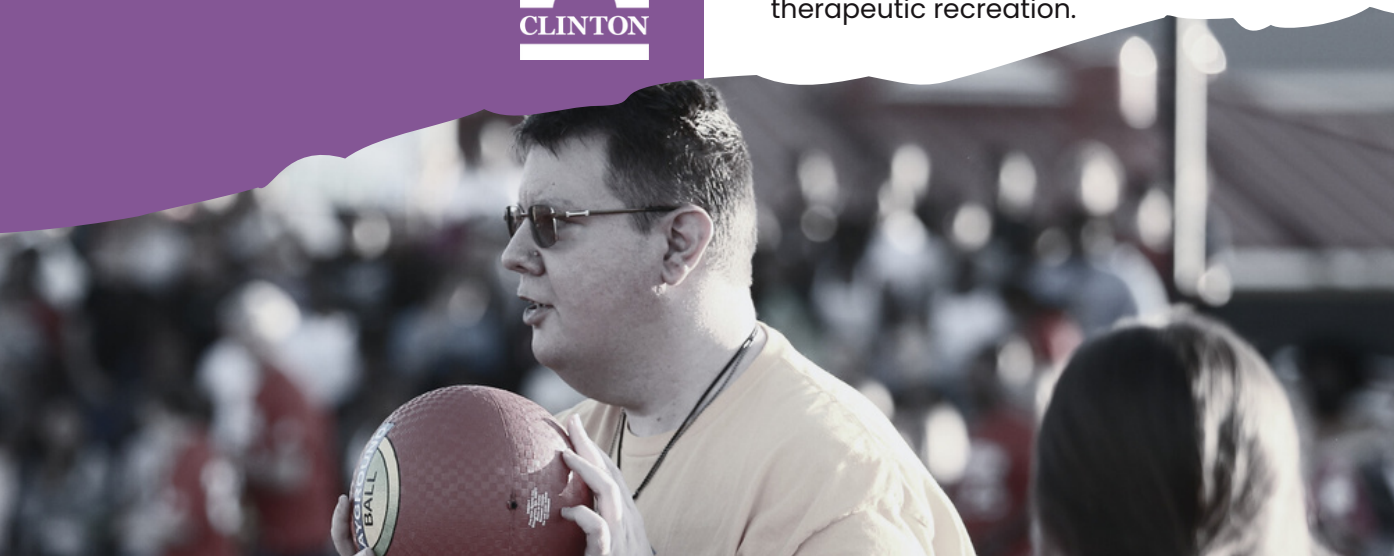
