About Us

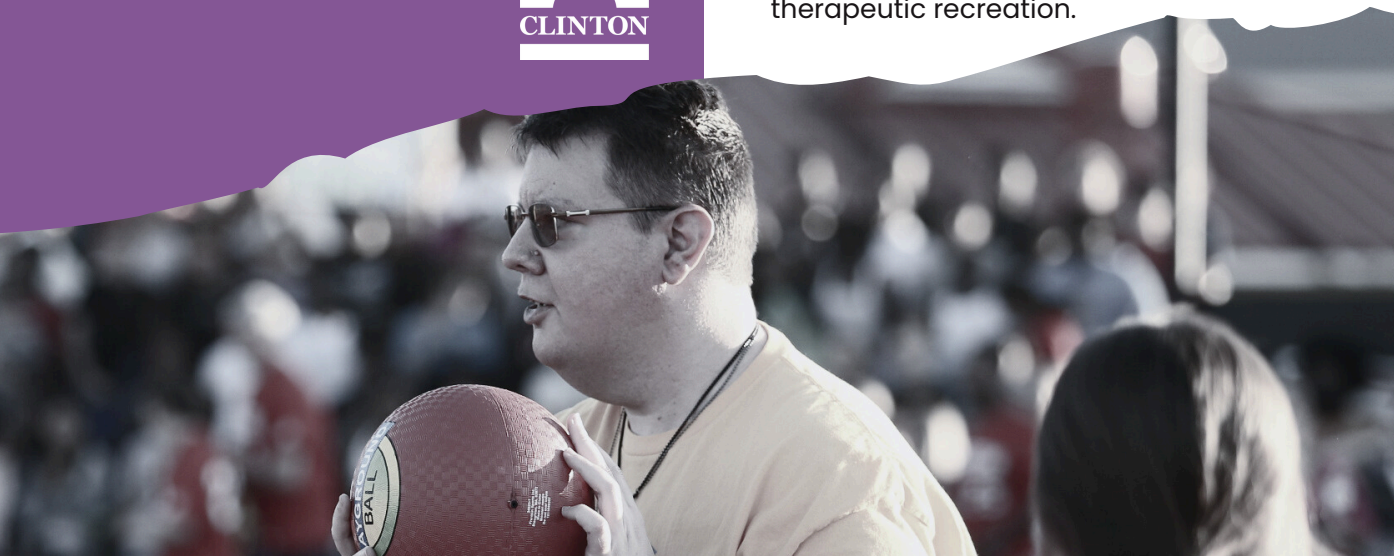
