Action for June 3, 2025 Meeting of Board of Aldermen

The Review Committee met on May 22, 2025 and took the following actions that need to presented to the Board of Alderman on June 3, 2025:

- The Committee is requesting approval of Change Order #4 from McGee Construction. The CO request includes (1) the extension of time (13 days) due to issues requiring additional erosion control measures and water runoff abatement. The measures included relocation of wattles, the addition of rock check dams and a temporary construction entrance to the MDOT property, all with a cumulative effect on the project budget of \$29,207.66. Details of each of these items are included in the attached package. Status: Change Order #4 for McGee Construction approved by the Review Committee as presented.
- Century Construction (Construction Manager as Advisor) requested approval to proceed with the bidding for Phase 2 of the project. The potential contractors have been pre-qualified and the City has approved the list. A proposed timeline was also presented to the Review Committee. After some discussion, the Review Committee voted to present the request to proceed to the Board of Aldermen at the June 3 meeting. Status: The Review Committee is in favor of the request to proceed with Phase 2 bid process.
- For informational purposes only: The Review Committee reviewed the rendering of the Baptist Clinic. The committee heard an explanation from Rob Farr (CDFL) that the rendering as presented meets the design standards envisioned by the Committee. We acknowledge that the City has formal procedures for the approval all building designs. The Review Committee is in support of the design as presented. Status: No action to be taken by the Board of Aldermen at this time.

Please consider this memo to be documentation of approval by the Rising Spring Review Committee for the first two actions described above. These actions should be included on the June 3rd Agenda for the Board of Aldermen for consideration.
