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change order and final pay request in the amount of \$114,682.00 to Mims, Inc. for the Woodmoor subdivision force main relocation. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

Upon presentation by Phillip Lilley, Director of Public Works, **MOTION** made by Alderwoman Jones, **SECONDED** by Alderman Chapman, the Board approved the lowest and best quote for the replacement of a large-diameter check valve at the Highway 80 Water Tank. Labor from Utility Maintenance for \$15,200; materials from Central Pipe for \$9,597.48. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

**DISCUSSION/ACTION - APPROVAL OF THE LOWEST AND BEST QUOTE FOR A 6X6 DIESEL ENGINE SEWER PUMP**

Upon presentation by Phillip Lilley, Director of Public Works, **MOTION** made by Alderwoman Oliver, **SECONDED** by Alderman Chapman, the Board approved the lowest and best quote for a 6x6 diesel engine sewer pump from Hydra Service, Inc. for \$71,419. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**



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**DISCUSSION/ACTION — APPROVAL TO INCREASE PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEE HOURLY SALARIES**

Upon presentation by Phillip Lilley, Director of Public Works, **MOTION** made by Alderman Chapman, and **SECONDED** by Alderwoman Jones, the Board approved increasing Raheem Myles' hourly salary from \$17.36 to \$18.05 for successful completion of the Water Operator Certification. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

Upon presentation by Phillip Lilley, Director of Public Works, **MOTION** made by Alderman Lott, and **SECONDED** by Alderwoman Oliver, the Board approved increasing John Birden's hourly salary from \$15.45 to \$17.00 for promotion to an open Foreman position. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

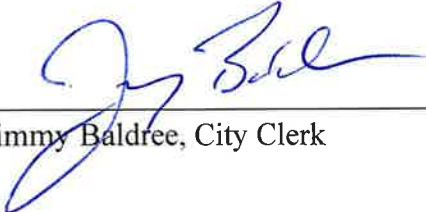
**MOTION TO ADJOURN**
